- Openreach FTTP pricing – See appendix 1 for spreadsheet of figures and address which will need to be included in the scheme, all addresses would need to sign up to scheme for us to be eligible for the government grant, each house hold will just need to sign up to a 12-month line rental.
- **Holmlea planning and barn demo 19/4402C-** The Parish Council received a verbal update from the homeowner and local resident Mr. K Threlfall, regarding the planning application and demolition of the barn. Main points are:
  - Cheshire East Council, advised Mr. Threlfall that there was not a requirement for a Planning application and that he could withdraw his application and apply after 6 weeks for a demolition notice
  - A demolition notice was granted and from 16<sup>th</sup> Jan the barn could be demolished.
  - Ed Cratchley the Planning officer – Clerk to Action a follow up email for consistency
  - Hedge was removed and is being replaced, this will be a drive to a field and only for agriculture use. HPC had concerns over when the hedge was removed as we

believed it was done over the bird nesting season but Mr. Threlfall assured us it was removed mid Feb

- The new garage is classed as a permitted development garage and does not require a further application – Clerk to action an email to Planning to confirm.

- **Onward parish activities and plans**

- Trees and Birds Boxes – Cllr Warner and Cllr Lowe, to look at siting the bird boxes, and AP Matthews to look at the trees and location.
- To be noted that more wildflowers and trees are needed in the area. Action for Autumn to plant.

- **Alsager Road Cars**

- HPC have received 5 complaints regarding the car situation, - parked on Alsager road and looking unsightly.
- Action to chase up correspondence from Cheshire East
- Action Letter to go out to residents on Alsager Rd concerning the cars from HPC
- Check ownership of land and property

**- Cllr G Warner**

Narrow Boat resident ongoing abuse each night at 11pm from youths, Action for Cllr Warner to drop a police information card at the narrow boat, it was suggested a log of evidence to be kept. Cllr Holt to send email to PCSO Holt regarding the matter seeking help and advise

Any updates regarding the dead animals on hr stretch of canal? – None, not further animals have been spotted dead, it looks like a one of situation- but emails were sent to Cheshire East Environmental Health, the Environment Agency and also a call logged with the Police.

**-Cllr K Lowe –** Action to put speed signs out near property
